

## GARDASIL HPV IMMUNIZATION

Gardasil is a vaccine to protect against the following conditions caused by HPV:

- a. Cervical cancer
- b. Pre-cancerous conditions of the cervix
- c. Genital Warts
- d. Vaginal and vulvar lesions

Gardasil is administered to females between the ages of 9 and 26 years old.

Gardasil is given in 3 doses according to the following schedule:

- a. First dose: You will be given a card with your next immunization dates.
- b. Second dose: Two months after first dose
- c. Third dose: Six months after first dose

Your Gardasil injection appointments can be simply scheduled as “Lab Appointments” through the front-desk or at check-out.

Check your insurance for coverage. You may provide your insurance company with the diagnosis code and vaccine and injection codes.
